2. What reasons might Robbie have for asking Jas to go with him for coffee? Do you think Georgia is overreacting? Why?

3. Do you think that Georgia's assumption about Robbie's reason for inviting Jas to coffee is correct? Or do you think that Georgia jumped to conclusions in her jealousy? How might you react in her situation? What do you think it will take for her to forgive Jas?

4. Is Jas operating under the same assumption as Georgia? Did Jas do the right thing by agreeing to go with Robbie? Why or why not?

5. Who is introduced in the second half of the February chapter? What is his/ her role in the novel?

6. What are Georgia's suspicions regarding Jem? Why? Do you think she is correct? Why or why not?

7. Why do you think Rennison chose to introduce Jem at this point in the novel? What will his role in the story be?

8. In what way does his presence affect Georgia? Is she right in her assumptions about him? Why or why not? What is the relationship between Jem and Georgia's mother?
