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You will be responsible for completing FIVE of the following tasks throughout the In-Class Novel Study.

Numbers 1 & 2 on the list are MANDATORY which means everyone must complete them. The remaining three items you may choose from the rest of the list. Each Item is worth 20 points with a breakdown of what should be included in each.

## **MANITORY ITEMS:**

1. **Letter to a character:** You are to write a letter to a character of the novel. In this letter you are to include a discussion of the story along with any compliments, criticisms or suggestions of what they did. (minimum 250 words)

2. **Time Chart:** You are to create a time chart of the main events in the novel. This may be done as chapter by chapter or every few chapters. There must be a minimum of 10 events represented. Marks are given for creativity and neatness.

## **CHOICE ITEMS (Complete Any THREE):**

- **3. Public Service Announcement Video or Poster:** Create a public service announcement about an issue that arises in the novel (could be about safety, health, relationships, etc.)
  - Follows the 5 Information guidelines for a PSA (Page 331 of text) 20 points
- **4.** Recreate a Scene From the novel in the form of a video: Create a script and act out a scene from the novel (5 minutes in length). Can include you and friends.

**5. Like/Dislike:** write a short, comparative essay about what you liked and disliked about the novel. (minimum 500 words)
