The quiz will consist of an unseen selection followed by a series of questions.

To answer these questions well, you must be familiar with the following concepts:

- **Make Connections (Page 2)** – Text to self, text to text, text to world connections. Be sure you can make connections while reading.
- **Develop Ideas (Page 24)** – Choosing a topic, narrowing the topic, knowledge of topic, etc. Be sure you are able to explain how authors develop their ideas in writing.
- **Recognize Purpose and Audience (Page 38-39)** – What are the **four** possible purposes of a text? Who is it intended for (audience)? What visual elements would appeal to certain groups of people? Etc.
- **Sequence Text Pattern (Page 46)** – Be sure you are familiar with the characteristics of sequence text pattern (events are written about in a particular order and the order is important; text is arranged in numbered or alphabetical steps; lists/bullets are sometimes used; keywords like *first*, *soon*, *now*, *before*, *later*, etc. are used).
