During our time at Birch Brook you have an opportunity to further your understanding of what it means to be a global citizen. Your task is to choose and complete one of the assignments below. Regardless of which option you choose, your work must focus on the theme of **Nature and Conservation**. For example, you might like to explore such issues as pollution, environmental responsibility, water usage, habitat protection, endangered species, etc.

Working in **groups of 1 - 3**, complete only **one** of the following assignment options:

Option 1 – Poetry Assignment:

- Write 3 poems, each representing a different form of poetry studied in class: Couplet,
 Triplet, Quatrain, Cinquain, Diamante, Limerick, Nonsense, Haiku, Tanka, Lyric
 Poem
- Provide **an illustration** to accompany each poem. The illustration must connect to the poem.
- Each poem must have a title. You should also title your illustration.

Option 2 – Photo Essay:

- Create a **photo essay** containing **10-15 images** complete with **a description** for each image. **Descriptions are to be limited to a maximum of 144 characters**.
- Your photo essay must be done in electronic format (i.e., PowerPoint slide show).
- Your photo essay must have a title slide.
- Your may put music to your slide show but this is not a requirement.

<u>Note</u>: It is important that you are able to use the technology you choose to take your pictures with. For example, if you use your iPhone to take your photos, make sure you know how to move your pictures to a PC or laptop in order to create your slideshow.
