- Where did they come from?
- What lifestyle did they follow?
- Where did they originally settle?
- What kind of relationship did they have with European settlers?
- What area do they live in today?
- Draw an illustration to reflect something of Mi'Kmaq culture.

3.Innu (p.30-31) 16 marks

- Where did they live and what did they call it?
- What is the Innu language called?
- What were their early numbers?
- What are the two main groups and how are they different?
- Result of European contact.
- Draw an illustration to reflect something of Innu culture.

4.Inuit (p.31-32) 12 marks

- What was the Inuit lifestyle?
- Where do the Inuit live?
- Result of European contact
- Describe types of housing
- Describe types of clothing
- Draw an illustration to reflect something of Inuit culture.
